Centre for Research in Anthropology (CRIA) has an open call for 4 (four) Research Initiation Fellowships (BII) under the scope of the programme "Verão com Ciência", financed by the Special Support "Verão com Ciência" awarded by the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P MCTES - national funds (PIDACC).

Reference and number of fellowships:

BII_Laboh: 2 fellowships

BII_LivePolitics: 2 fellowships

Scientific Area: Anthropology and/or Archaeology

Admission criteria: students must be enrolled (or in condition to be enrolled) in an undergraduate course, integrated master, master or enrolled in courses that do not confer an academic degree, as per articles 5.º and 6.º from Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação da FCT, I.P..

Candidates that have already benefited from research grants (regardless of the typology), directly or indirectly financed by FCT, are not eligible.

Work plan

BII_LABOH: The work plan includes the preparation, inventorying and organization of bioanthropological and archaeological material for study, as well as the processing of (varied) documentation related to excavation contexts.

BII_LivePolitics: The work plan aims at: 1) compiling the legislative measures undertaken towards essential workers in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic in Portugal; 2) undertake an exploratory study addressing the confinement impacts on familial and domestic relations in Portugal.

Work place: the work plans will be developed at CRIA, under scientific supervision of Doctor Francisca Alves Cardoso (BII_LABOH) and Doctor Antónia Lima (BII_LivePolitics).

Duration of the fellowship(s): The fellowship will last for one month, non-renewable, due to start between July 15th and August 1st 2022.



Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount corresponds to €486,12, according to the Table of Allowances for Grants approved under FCT Regulation No. 950/2019, of 16 December.

Selection method: The selection process is based on the curricular path evaluation (70%) and motivation letter assessment (30%). The jury reserves the right not to award the fellowships if applicants' profile is not aligned with the fellowships' work plans.

Selection panel: Dr. Francisca Alves Cardoso (Chairperson); Members: Doctor Antónia Lima and Doctor Patrícia Alves de Matos.

Application submission and deadline: The call is open from July 6th to 12th, 2022.

Applications must be submitted at CRIA's website: https://cria.org.pt/pt/emprego-e-bolsas, accompanied by the following documentation:

A motivation letter (indicating the preferred scholarship: LABOH or LivePolitics.

Curriculum Vitae.

Qualification certificate(s) including a breakdown of the marks obtained in the disciplines of the respective course and final classification (if applicable).

Proof of enrolment in study cycles conferring or not conferring a degree (Although the applicants must be enrolled in a cycle of studies leading to the attribution of an academic degree or courses that do not confer an academic degree, at the time of application it is not necessary for the applicants to have made such an enrollment.)

Applications sent through any other means will not be considered.

Results notification: All candidates will be notified of the selection process by email.

The presentation of all documents is mandatory for signing of the fellowship contract, including proof(s) of academic degree(s) and/or proof of enrolment in a course not conferring a degree and/or recognition of academic degree obtained abroad.

Academic degrees obtained abroad require recognition by a Portuguese Institution according to Decree Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance no. 33/2019, of January 25.

Non-discrimination and equal access policy
