

Research Fellowship

The Centre for Research in Anthropology (CRIA) opens a Call for one (1) research fellowship (Master's degree) under the pluri-annual funding R&D units (UID/04038/2020), funded by national funds through FCT/MCTES (PIDDAC).

Main research field: Anthropology

Admission requirements

General

The call is open to candidates:

a) holding a Master's degree in Anthropology or other Social Sciences and Humanities pertinent to the project

b) enrolled on a PhD in the area of Anthropology or in non-degree courses on similar áreas (in accordance with Article 6 of the current Regulations for Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.).

Although the recipients must be enrolled in a cycle of studies leading to the attribution of an academic degree or in a course not conferring an academic degree, at the time of application it is not necessary for the candidate to have made such an enrollment, and proof of enrollment must be presented until the fellowship is contractualized. Candidates are only required to meet the requirements to enroll in the training offer. If there are candidates already enrolled (including attending a course), they compete on an equal footing with those who are not enrolled.

Specific

- a) Fieldwork experience with participant observation and interviews;
- b) Master Portuguese and English languages (oral and written).

Work Plan

The selected candidate must carry out the following tasks associated with the exploratory research project "Shared Sea: the implications of electricity generation off the Portuguese Green Coast", in close collaboration with the project team:



1. Collect and analyse documents and statistics on the context under study, particularly in socio-economic terms;

2. Outline and carry out fieldwork with participant observation, open interviews and informal conversations with relevant social actors, as well as writing detailed field notes on the information collected in the field regarding the object of study;

- 3. Transcribe some recorded interviews; and
- 4. Produce a final report on the developed activities.

Legislation and applicable regulation

FCT Research Grants Regulation, approved by Regulation No. 950/2019, published in the II Series of the DR of 16 December 2019, by the Research Grant Holder Statute approved by Law No. 40/2004, of 18 August, as amended.

Workplace and supervision:

The workplace is located at CRIA and/or other places necessary for the development of the research activities, under the scientific orientation of Luís Silva (PhD)

Duration: The fellowship will last 3 months and is expected to start in the 1st October 2022.

Amount: The fellowship amount corresponds to € 1.144,64, according to FCT's Table of monthly maintenance allowances. The amount will the paid monthly, via bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection process will be based on the curriculum evaluation:

- a) participation in research projects (10%);
- b) Scientific publications (15%);

c) extension and dissemination activities, namely in the context of promoting scientific culture and practices and in the dissemination of knowledge and research results to society (academic and non-academic audiences) (10%);

d) Master Portuguese and English languages (10%);

e) Assessment of the motivation letter, that must mention applicant's motivation and interest in the subject of the project, as well as relevant previous experience (35%); and

f) Experience in anthropological fieldwork (with participant observation and interviews) (20%).



Candidates will be classified and ranked, according to the previous criteria, on a scale of 0 to 100.

At the end of the CV evaluation, the top three candidates will be invited for an interview.

The final classification will be given by the score of the curricular evaluation (70%) and by the score of the interview (30%).

In case of a tie, the chair of the selection committee has a casting vote.

The jury reserves the right not to award a scholarship if no candidate meets the required profile.

Advertising / notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be published through an ordered list and all the candidates will be notified by e-mail.

Application submission and deadline:

The call is open from the 30 August to the 12 September 2022.

Applications shall be submited at https://cria.org.pt/en/jobs-scholarships until the deadline defined in this public notice.

The application includes the following documents:

- 1. Motivation letter;
- 2. Curriculum Vitae (dated and signed);

3. Certificates of academic qualifications, specifying the final classification and, if possible, the marks obtained in all the subjects taken;

4. Proof of enrollment in a doctoral programme or course not conferring an academic degree. Although the recipients must be enrolled in a doctoral programme or in a course not conferring an academic degree, at the time of application it is not necessary for the candidate to have made such an enrollment,



Applications submitted by other means will not be considered. Candidates who formalise their application incorrectly or who do not prove the requirements will be excluded from admission to the competition. In case of doubt, the selection board may require any candidate to produce documents to support their statements.

* Academic degrees obtained abroad require recognition by a Portuguese Institution according to Decree Law no. 66/2018, of August 16th and Administrative Rule no. 33/2019, of January 25th. The presentation of the recognition is mandatory for the signature of the contract.
