The Centre for Research in Anthropology (CRIA) opens a Call for one (1) Post-Doctoral Fellowship under the project "Avaliação Externa da Iniciativa 'Participação Climática' da Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian, funded by Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian

Main research field: Psychology

Admission requirements

General:

The call is open to candidates holding a PhD in Psychology), with the following requirements:

- a) doctoral degree obtained in the three years previous to the date of the application;
- b) no previous postdoctoral research fellowship with CRIA;
- c) the total duration of postdoctoral fellowship cannot exceed three years.

Post-doctoral research cannot be developed in the same organisation where the research that led to the award of the doctoral degree was carried out.

Specific:

- Research experience in communication, public participation, and climate change in Portugal;
- Experience with methodologies such as observation and fieldwork, interviews, and focus groups;
- Fluency in Portuguese and English.

Preferential requirements:

- Ability to work as part of a team;
- Excellent written communication skills.

Work Plan

The selected candidate must carry out the following tasks associated to the project:

- Conduct fieldwork, including monitoring initiatives in different regions of the country;
- Moderate focus groups and conduct interviews in various regions of the country;
- Analyse data from focus groups and interviews;
- Contribute to reports and other publications within the scope of the project;
- Participate in the organisation and management activities of the project.



Applicable laws and regulations (activity basis):

Workplace:

The workplace is located at CRIA UMINHO and/or other places necessary for the development of the research activities, under the scientific orientation of Dr. Anabela Carvalho.

Duration:

The fellowship will last 3 months and is expected to start on April 1st 2025.

Amount:

The fellowship amount corresponds to 1.801,00€ according to Annex I – Table of monthly maintenance allowances, based on FCT Rules for Research Fellowships in effect. In addition, there is a corresponding voluntary social insurance, if the candidate chooses to assign it, as well as an insurance for personal accidents. The amount will the paid monthly, via bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection process will be developed based on the curriculum evaluation, privileging the general view of the scientific merits:

- a) general scientific coherence of the CV 30 %;
- b) scientific production (including publications) 20%;
- c) relevant experience on the described areas of the call 35%;
- d) letter of motivation 15%.

The jury reserves the right not to award the fellowship if none of the candidates corresponds to the expected profile.

Advertising / notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be published through an ordered list and all the candidates will be notified by e-mail.

Application submission and deadline:

The call is open from the 3rd to the 14th February 2025.

Applications, in Portuguese or English, must be submitted on the CRIA website at https://cria.org.pt/en/jobs-scholarships accompanied by the following required documentation (PDF):

- . Letter of motivation;
- . Curriculum Vitae (detailed)
- . Certificate of PhD degree;
- . Declaration of honour with the duration of previous postdoctoral fellowships, if applicable.

Candidates who incorrectly formalize their application or who do not produce proof of meeting the necessary requirements are excluded from admission to the competition. The selection committee has the power, in case of doubt, to require any candidate to submit documents confirming their statements.

* Academic degrees obtained abroad require recognition by a Portuguese Institution according to Decree Law no. 66/2018 of 16th August and Ordinance no. 33/2019, of 25th January. The presentation of the recognition is mandatory for the signing of the contract.
